Duties included individual therapy, case management, psychological testing, and case presentations. Other half was spent attending courses in social, biological, psychiatric, and psychological gerontology, and a fifth course in family therapy. Special assignments included nursing home consultation one-half day a week for 6 months and the offering of a life review course. *Second year (9/80–8/81)* consisted of a 3-month half-time administrative rotation as assistant chief of the geriatric clinic, a 6-month half-time consultation to the medical units of the Houston VA, and a 3-month half-time research rotation reviewing the reminiscence literature and doing research on locus of control in the elderly. Other activities were nursing home consultation on behavioral management, inpatient neuropsychological testing, attending an advanced family therapy course, long-term psychotherapy with a young adult, and outreach consultation.

Sept 1978 - Aug 1979

Ohio State University Medical School, Columbus, Ohio. APA-approved internship.

The internship was divided into three 4-month rotations: *Sept-Dec. 1978*--Adult outpatient rotation involved supervised psychodynamic psychotherapy, intake interviews, family therapy seminars, psychological consultation, supervision of a practicum student, and vocational counseling. The last month was devoted entirely to work on the psychiatric consultation service to the main hospital. *Jan-April 1979*--Adult inpatient rotation. This rotation was divided into two 2-month experiences on different inpatient units. Duties included primary care for approximately 8 patients, participation as co-therapist in an inpatient group, supervision of medical students, and psychological consultation. *May-Aug 1979*--Child rotation. Duties involved supervised child inpatient and outpatient psychodynamic therapy, family therapy, psychological consultation, experience in the hyperactive clinic, and child therapy seminar.
